

Camp Elachee Junior Counselors-In-Training Leadership Program

The Camp Elachee Junior Counselors-In-Training (CIT) Leadership Program is a special opportunity for **rising 7th and 8th graders**. Supervised by the Camp Director and mentored by the Program Assistant and Camp Counselors, Junior CITs will learn the skills needed to work with children in a camp setting. **Limited spots are available each week!**

Once accepted and registered, Junior CITs will be assigned a camp group with which they will assist throughout the week. CITs will help Camp Counselors provide activities to campers in a safe and well-supervised environment while also learning and practicing new leadership skills. *All applicants will be interviewed.*

Program Fee: \$150 per CIT, per camp week. Optional after camp care is \$60 per CIT, per camp week.

Program Hours: Monday-Friday, 7:45 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

CIT Responsibilities:

Participants in the Junior CIT program work under the same ground rules as all staff members, which include the following:

- No cell phone use.
- Arrive at Elachee on time to make necessary preparations for the day.
- Assist in taking attendance and ensuring that all campers in his/her group are well supervised and within sight or sound of a staff person at all times.
- Assist Camp Counselors with daily education, craft, and recreation activities for their specific camp group.
- Use only positive and appropriate language.
- Follow the specific dress attire. Participants will receive a shirt that is specific for the Junior CIT program.
- Follow all safety procedures to ensure the safety of all campers and staff.
- Help assess and respond to the needs of each camper.
- Work as a team with other Elachee staff members.
- Help maintain the facilities, equipment, and supplies in a clean and orderly manner.
- Will report directly to their assigned Camp Counselor.

Certificate of Completion:

At the end of summer camp, all CITs that successfully complete the program will be welcomed back to Elachee for a Celebration Party! Lunch and a Certificate of Completion will be provided.
